Later Visit One of the busiest water temples in Indonesia, Tirta Empul is a temple considered sacred by Balinese Hindu community. The temple has several holy springs which are said to have been created by The God Indra and believed to be blessed water that could purify those who bathe there. Tirta Empul is dedicated to Vishnu, the Hindu God of water. In the Balinese language, Tirta Empul loosely translated means water gushing from the earth, which for this reason Tirta Empul is regarded as a holy spring. The Tirta Empul Temple includes shrines to Shiva, Vishnu, Brahma, as well as one for Indra and Mount Batur. The onshore site is dotted with smaller shrines alongside visitor's leisure facilities that Comprise restaurants, shops and a cultural park presenting regular dance performances. The temple is located in the Beraban village of the Tabanan Regency, an approximate 20km northwest of Kuta and is included on most tours to Bali's western and central regions.

Day 05 - Excursion to Nusa Penida by Shared Speedboat | Mesmerize in the amazing rock formations and views

Nusa Penida Island -Wake up in the morning, have a hearty breakfast in the hotel, and get ready for the most exciting day in Bali.

• Get ready and board your transfer to the Sanur Harbor, from where you will be taking a boat to reach the Nusa Penida Island.

• Start your Nusa Penida tour by hiking through a precarious and narrow trail down a mountain onto the shoreline to reach the famous Kelingking Beach.

• Next, visit the Angel's Billabong which is a beautiful natural rock pool that opens straight to the ocean and can be accessed easily by climbing down a few steps.

• Just close to the Angel's Billabong is the Broken Bay which is a large rock archway from where you can marvel at the ocean as it flows in and out of a natural bowl surrounded by towering cliffs. in the afternoon, take a stopover for lunch and treat your taste buds to the traditional Balinese cuisine.

Later, board your boat back to the main island of Bali. Return back to the hotel for an overnight stay in Kuta.

Things Not To Do In Bali

It shouldn't be a big surprise why people all over the world flock to Bali to spend their vacation. To make sure you do not land in trouble while visiting this place, we have put together a list of 9 things not to do in Bali that you should take care of:

- Do Not Enter The Temples With Your Shoes On.
- Avoid Drinking Tap Water
- Do Not Visit Temples. Wearing Revealing Clothes
- Avoid Using Your Left Hand For Giving Or Accepting Things.
- Drug Possession And Consumption Can Land You In Jail.
- Maintain Decorum During Nyepi.
- Honking Without Reason Is Prohibited.
- Do Not Point Your Toes Towards A
- Buddha Statue Or Symbol.
- Do Not Mock Religious Processions.

It is advisable to maintain decorum when religious processions are organized on the streets, especially if it is a funeral procession. A Hindu funeral procession is called Ngaben in Bali, also known as Pelebon or Pitra Yadnya. If you happen to come by a Ngaben it is best to not make any noise and maintain silence till it or you pass or you will definitely end up being confronted for your behavior.
