1. Avoid public displays of affection (holding hands, kissing).
2. Dress modestly when visiting mosques or temples.
3. Remove shoes before entering mosques or homes.
4. Avoid pointing with your feet or touching people with your left hand.
5. Respect Ramadan fasting rules (if traveling during Ramadan).

Safety and Security:

1. Avoid traveling alone at night.
2. Be cautious with strangers and avoid hitchhiking.
3. Keep valuables secure and use hotel safes.
4. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash.
5. Follow local advice during emergencies.

Local Laws and Regulations:

1. Don't take photos of military or government buildings.
2. Avoid bringing prohibited items (e.g., narcotics, firearms).
3. Respect visa requirements and regulations.
4. Don't engage in illegal activities (e.g., bribery).

5. Follow traffic rules and regulations.

Health and Hygiene:
