Day 01: Arrival at Guwahati – Transfer to Tejpur Distance: Approx. 240 Km | Drive Time: 6-7 Hours

Upon arrival at Guwahati Airport, our representative will warmly receive you and assist you for your onward journey to Arunachal Pradesh.

Guests are requested to arrive before 11:00 AM, as the journey towards Bhalukpong begins by **12:00 Noon**. Maximum waiting time at the airport will be **30 minutes**.

Drive through the lush green plains of Assam, passing charming villages, tea gardens, and scenic countryside before reaching **Tejpur**

Upon arrival, check into your hotel/resort. Spend the evening at leisure,

Day 02 - Bhalukpong to Dirang Distance: Approx. 180 Km | Drive Time: 6-7 Hours

After breakfast, begin your spectacular drive towards Dirang.

As you ascend into the Eastern Himalayas, witness dramatic changes in landscape—from dense forests and winding mountain roads to sparkling streams, waterfalls, and traditional tribal settlements.

The journey itself is an unforgettable experience filled with breathtaking Himalayan views and pristine natural beauty.

Upon arrival in **Dirang**, check into your hotel. Nestled amidst mountains and valleys, Dirang is known for its pleasant weather, apple orchards, kiwi farms, and serene atmosphere.

Enjoy the evening at leisure.

Day 03 - Sangti Valley & Mandala Top Excursion | Distance: Approx. 80 Km | Duration: Full Day Excursion

After breakfast, proceed to the enchanting **Sangti Valley**, one of Arunachal Pradesh's most scenic

hidden gems.

Surrounded by majestic mountains and traversed by the sparkling Sangti River, the valley is famous for its lush meadows, apple orchards, kiwi plantations, traditional Monpa villages, and mesmerizing landscapes.

Later, visit the spectacular **Mandala Top**, renowned for its panoramic Himalayan views and the magnificent arrangement of **108 Buddhist Stupas**, symbolizing peace, spirituality, and harmony.

The stunning viewpoints offer unforgettable vistas of the surrounding mountain ranges.

Note: Mandala Top sightseeing is subject to road conditions and local clearance.

Return to Dirang by evening.

Day 04: Dirang to Tawang via Sela Pass Distance: Approx. 150 Km | Drive Time: 7-8 Hours

After breakfast, check out and proceed towards the beautiful town of Tawang.

One of India's most spectacular high-altitude mountain passes, surrounded by snow-covered peaks and pristine alpine lakes.

Sela Lake

A breathtaking glacial lake reflecting the beauty of the surrounding Himalayan landscape.

Jaswant Garh War Memorial

A moving tribute to the bravery and sacrifice of Rifleman Jaswant Singh Rawat during the 1962 Indo-China War.

Nuranang Waterfall (Jung Falls)

A magnificent waterfall cascading through dense mountain forests, creating a picture-perfect setting.

Arrive in Tawang by evening and check into your hotel.

Sungester Lake (Madhuri Lake)

A mesmerizing lake surrounded by snow-capped mountains and scenic landscapes. Its pristine beauty made it famous after its appearance in the Bollywood movie *Koyla*.

Bum La Pass

Situated at an altitude of over 15,000 feet near the Indo-China border, Bum La Pass offers breathtaking views and a rare opportunity to visit one of India's most significant frontier locations.

Enroute High-Altitude Lakes

Explore several picturesque lakes and viewpoints, each offering spectacular Himalayan scenery.

Afternoon Sightseeing:

- Tawang War Memorial
- Urgelling Monastery (Birthplace of the 6th Dalai Lama)

Evening Highlight:

Attend the inspiring **Light & Sound Show** at the Tawang War Memorial, showcasing stories of courage, sacrifice, and patriotism.

Day 06: Tawang to Bomdila via Sela Tunnel Distance: Approx. 190 Km | Drive

Time: 7-8 Hours

After breakfast, visit the magnificent **Tawang Monastery**, the largest monastery in India and the second-largest monastery in the world.

Founded in 1680, this revered monastery is perched at an altitude of nearly 10,000 feet and offers panoramic views of the Tawang Valley. Explore its beautiful prayer halls, ancient scriptures, vibrant murals, sacred relics, and the majestic golden Buddha statue.

Later, begin your scenic drive towards Bomdila via the modern **Sela Tunnel**, an engineering marvel that enhances connectivity through the Himalayan mountains.

Enjoy spectacular views of rugged peaks, alpine valleys, waterfalls, and charming mountain villages along the way.

Arrive in Bomdila by evening and check into your hotel.

The remainder of the day is free to relax and soak in the peaceful mountain atmosphere.

Day 07: Bomdila to Guwahati Distance: Approx. 350 Km | Drive Time: 8-9 Hours

After an early breakfast, begin your return journey towards Guwahati.

Upon arrival, check into your hotel in Guwahati (if applicable) and enjoy the evening at leisure.

Do's & Don'ts

Do's

- Respect the local culture and traditions,
- Dress modestly, especially when visiting temples and sacred sites,

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- Remove your shoes before entering someone's home or a place of worship,
 - Greet people with a traditional Indian greeting, such as "namaste",
 - Ask permission before taking photographs of people

Don'ts

- Do not touch someone with your feet, as this is considered disrespectful
- Do not eat with your left hand, as the left hand is traditionally used for cleaning oneself after using the toilet
- Do not point with your finger or use your fingers to beckon someone, as this is considered impolite
- Do not publicly display affection, as this is not accepted in Indian culture
- Do not criticize or make fun of local customs or beliefs.

It is always a good idea to be mindful of local customs and to respect the traditions and culture of the place you are visiting.

Important Note for Foreign Nationals:

Foreign Nationals are required to obtain a **Restricted Area Permit (RAP)** to enter Arunachal Pradesh. The applicable permit charges and processing fees are **not included in the package cost** and will be payable additionally by the guest.

· Please note that, as per prevailing Government and Defence regulations, foreign nationals are generally **not permitted to visit Bum La Pass and Sungester (Madhuri) Lake**, even with a valid RAP.

· In such cases, alternative sightseeing options may be suggested locally, subject to availability and permissions. Guests may utilize the time at leisure or opt for additional sightseeing through a **separate taxi arrangement (at an additional cost)**.
